

This 64 years old lady had bilateral cataract extraction through couching about 20 years back at the remote area in Pakistan. She lost her right eye as a result of Phaco Anaphylactic Endophthalmitis, as is obvious from the disorganized anterior segment. However she kept going with the left Aphakic correction for few years till she developed Aphakic Glaucoma with sky high IOP around 48 mm Hg well controlled with maximum medical therapy. She could manage 6/12p (e +10DS/-0.75DC at 180). She was interested to get rid of glasses and ongoing intermittent pain and irritable eye. She underwent Left PPV+cataractous crystalline lens removal out of the vitreous cavity through anterior approach and 360 argon laser indirect laser on 17.07.14. She is on some lubricant gel, ointment as well homemade Cyclosporin eye drops for dry eye. Her BCVA e +3.50DS/-2.DC @ 74 is 6/6. She is very happy but being illiterate, does go without glasses most of the times. There are different secondary IOLs available on the market but I have mastered Ophtec Phakic and Aphakic IOL implantation which I have found the best with promising results & no side effects.
